No	TASK
1	Inspect the roof for winter damage (missing shingles, leaks, debris)
2	Clean gutters and downspouts to prevent water damage
3	Check exterior drainage to avoid standing water near the foundation
4	Service and clean the HVAC system before summer heat
5	Inspect windows and doors for air leaks and seal them as needed
6	Pressure wash siding, driveways, and decks
7	Inspect and repair any damage to fences, porches, or outdoor structures
8	Clean and inspect attic ventilation to prevent moisture buildup

1	Trim trees and branches near the roof to prevent storm damage	
2	Inspect and clean outdoor lighting and security systems	
3	Test sump pump functionality before hurricane season	
4	Check the attic and basement for signs of mold or leaks	
5	Inspect and clean the exterior of the AC unit	
6	Check for signs of pests (termites, rodents, insects) and seal entry points	
7	Examine deck and patio for loose boards or safety hazards

1	Clean gutters and downspouts after leaves have fallen	
2	Check the roof for missing or damaged shingles before winter storms	
3	Inspect and seal gaps around doors and windows to improve heating efficiency	
4	Test the heating system and replace filters	
5	Inspect and clean the fireplace and chimney	
6	Drain and winterize outdoor faucets and irrigation systems	
7	Check attic insulation and add more if needed	
8	Store or cover outdoor furniture

1	Monitor attic and roof for ice damming (if applicable)	
2	Inspect and replace weather stripping on doors and windows	
3	Check pipes in unheated areas to prevent freezing	
4	Keep walkways and driveways clear of ice and snow (if applicable)	
5	Test carbon monoxide and smoke detectors	
6	Inspect water heater for leaks or sediment buildup	
7	Reverse ceiling fans to circulate warm air downward	
8	Watch for condensation on windows, which can signal ventilation issues
